

CSL 2010

The fall CSL season will be starting in September. Please review Coast Soccer League Competition Rules and Regulations Section 10 and Section 13 found in your CSL Book or on the LBSRA web site www.lbsra.com , click on Coast Soccer League under Member Center. You can also go to www.coastsoccer.com, click on resources and go CSL rule 2010.

Below are procedures to be followed:

1. MATCH REPORTS (Section 13)

Home teams are required to provide an official CSL match report, along with a mailing envelop with the proper amount of postage affixed.

Check in players insuring that all players listed on the match report have a valid player pass for that team. Make sure that any player not playing is crossed off the roster. Please insure that on those team rosters for U16, U17, U18 and U19 which exceed eighteen (18) players that all players, over the 18 maximum game day roster are lined out. If there is no administrator/coach with a valid USYS administrator pass make a note on the match report AND THE GAME IS NOT TO BE PLAYED.

The center referee upon completion of the game will complete the match report. Report all cautions and send offs on the report. Have both teams sign the report.

2 .MAILING OF REPORT

MAKE A COPY OF THE MATCH REPORT FOR YOUR PERSONNEL RECORDS and mail the original match report to CSL using envelop provided. The center referee is responsibility for mailing of the match report, Include any USSF supplemental reports and any player passes withheld, remember you may have to add extra postage if the mailing is in excess of the minimum weight. Match reports are to be mailed within 24 hours of the match. The center referee will be fined \$50.00 if he cannot provide CSL with a copy (original or personnel copy) of a match report. Remember you may need to add postage.

3. Player Passes and send offs

All player and administrator passes are to be returned to appropriate team at the conclusion of the match, including those for players or administrators who were sent off for an offense other then assault, violent conduct and suspected falsification of documents. ONLY IN THE CASES OF ASSAULT, VIOLENT CONDUCT AND SUSPECTED FALSIFICATION OF DOCUMENTS SHOULD THE PLAYER OR ADMINISTRATOR PASS BE WITHHELD. A USSF supplemental report is completed for any pass withheld and mailed along with the pass and match report to CSL.

4. Game Times

Be at the game site 20 minutes before your first game dressed and ready to check in the teams. If you are late you will be fined \$20.00. All games shall start at their scheduled time. If at game time a team is short players, coach or player/ administrative passes a grace period of fifteen (15) minutes after the scheduled game time will be allowed. Player Passes as well as Coaches Passes must be presented before the game commences. The grace period may not be extended by the referee. If the game can't be played indicate on game report which team can't compete. DO NOT COLLECT FEES FROM EITHER TEAM. REPORT GAME TO YOUR ASSIGNOR AS A NO SHOW. Mail report to CSL.

5. No Shows

If you have been assigned a game and you have not received a cancellation notice by e-mail or phone and one or both teams are not able to play report game as no show to your assignor within 12 hours. DO NOT COLLECT GAME FEES.

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
