Something that will change!!! You will need to make copies of the game reports for your records as a LBSRA member doing CSL games. (Scan, Copy, or what ever you need to do) You must turn in the game report within 24hrs after doing your matches.

Only turn in the match YOU did as a Center Referee. NO more combining reports in the envelope provided. (please, don't make a stamp an issue)

NOT TURNING IN YOUR REPORT WILL RESULT IN A FINE. (\$50)

Registration information 2011 for LBSRA

You must go to the web site and down load the forms. (Calsouth.com.) Test for grade 8 will be given at our October Meeting. Mark you calendar Now.

Test for grade 8 only, 10-20-2010

Referees who are registered with the United States Soccer Federation (USSF) must renew their registration annually. To re-certify or maintain your current referee grade please follow the directions below and mail in all requirements with your registration form to the address at the end of this page. Referees going Emeritus must submit a note stating this with their registration form. The referee must have held the grade for a minimum of 3 years prior to the request. A registration is valid from January 1 thru December 31 of each year. Registration for the 2010 calendar year is now closed. Registrations must be submitted between September 1, 2010 to June 30, 2011.

PLEASE ALLOW 3 WEEKS FOR PROCESSING AND APPROVAL. ONCE APPROVED YOUR NAME WILL APPEAR ON THE REGISTERED OFFICIALS LIST. USSF MAILS OUT THE PACKETS, THIS CAN TAKE UP TO 1 MONTH FROM WHEN YOUR NAME IS LISTED ON THE WEBSITE.

RISK MANAGEMENT REQUIREMENT

All Cal South referees age 18 and up must have their Risk Management done to referee any youth games within Cal South. It can take up to 14 days for approval of your Live Scan fingerprinting to come back from the California Department of Justice. - YOU MUST GO TO CAL SOUTHS WEB SITE AND REGERISTER FOR THE CLINIC WHICH WILL BE POSTED. CAL SOUTH WANT'S YOU TO PAY ON LINE.**

Print 2 copies of the form, keep one for yourself Complete the form using one letter per square.

Complete as much of Step 1 as you can. If you are re-certifying, your USSF ID Number is required. If you don't know your USSF ID Number or can't locate it, go to USSF type in your password to find your number.

Current State Affiliation = CAS

Grade = Referee Grade, not your grade in school.

The DISTRICT field leave blank.

Re-certifying Referees should report the number of matches done in the past year in Step 3, Affiliated Game Experience For Prior Year. Write in the actual number of games done at each level. Do not use "X's" or check marks.

Read Step 5 and then check the appropriate box. If you have checked the "yes" box, please submit the following information with your form: description of offense, date, court, and sentence. Information is evaluated on a case by case basis in relationship to being a referee. If a box is not checked in Step 5, the form will be returned.

Sign and date your form on the signature line provided. Your signature attests that all information contained on the form is true and correct. Misrepresentation or falsification of facts are reason for possible dismissal. Unsigned forms will be returned.

CSL 2010

The fall CSL season will be starting in September. Please review Coast Soccer League Competition Rules and Regulations Section 10 and Section 13 found in your CSL Book or on the LBSRA web site www.lbsra.com , click on Coast Soccer League under Member Center. You can also go to www.coastsoccer.com , click on resources and go CSL rule 2010.

Below are procedures to be followed:

1. MATCH REPORTS (Section 13)

Home teams are required to provide an official CSL match report, along with a mailing envelop with the proper amount of postage affixed.

Check in players insuring that all players listed on the match report have a valid player pass for that team. Make sure that any player not playing is crossed off the roster. Please insure that on those team rosters for U16, U17, U18 and U19 which exceed eighteen (18) players that all players, over the 18 maximum game day roster are lined out. If there is no administrator/coach with a valid USYS administrator pass make a note on the match report **AND THE GAME IS NOT TO BE PLAYED.**

The center referee upon completion of the game will complete the match report. Report all cautions and send offs on the report. Have both teams sign the report.

2 .MAILING OF REPORT

MAKE A COPY OF THE MATCH REPORT FOR YOUR PERSONNEL RECORDS and mail the original match report to CSL using envelop provided. The center referee is responsibility for mailing of the match report, Include any USSF supplemental reports and any player passes withheld, remember you may have to add extra postage if the mailing is in excess of the minimum weight. Match reports are to be mailed within 24 hours of the match. The center referee will be fined \$50.00 if he cannot provide CSL with a copy (original or personnel copy) of a match report. Remember you may need to add postage.

3. Player Passes and send offs

All player and administrator passes are to be returned to appropriate team at the conclusion of the match, including those for players or administrators who were sent off for an offense other then assault, violent conduct and suspected falsification of documents. **ONLY IN THE CASES OF ASSAULT, VIOLENT CONDUCT AND SUSPECTED FALSIFICATION OF DOCUMENTS SHOULD THE PLAYER OR ADMINISTRATOR PASS BE WITHHELD.** A USSF supplemental report is completed for any pass withheld and mailed along with the pass and match report to CSL.

4. Game Times

Be at the game site 20 minutes before your first game dressed and ready to check in the teams. If you are late you will be fined \$20.00. All games shall start at their scheduled time. If at game time a team is short players, coach or player/administrative passes a grace period of fifteen (15) minutes after the scheduled game time will be allowed. Player Passes as well as Coaches Passes must be presented before the game commences. The grace period may not be extended by the referee. If the game can't be played indicate on game report which team can't compete. **DO NOT COLLECT FEES FROM EITHER TEAM. REPORT GAME TO YOUR ASSIGNOR AS A NO SHOW.** Mail report to CSL.

5. No Shows

If you have been assigned a game and you have not received a cancellation notice by e-mail or phone and one or both teams are not able to play report game as no show to your assignor within 12 hours.
DO NOT COLLECT GAME FEES. Kent Kirkland
