Coordinator Job

To protect and ensure a professional service to tournaments and leagues in charge and assist our referees, BSRA has committed to provide field referee coordinator.

Coordinator is an ambassador assigned to go in between our association, tournament director, coaches, layers and parents. So imagine how important task a head.

Steps to take:

- Coordinator must have a copy of the assigned refers, direction to fields, phone numbers and rules of the games.
 - Have USSF uniform on, ready in case to replace a referee.
 - present at the the site assigned, introduce yourself to tournament coordinator at site with your phone number and name.
 - check your schedule verses their schedule if a game moved add edge or cancelled.
 - ask them if they wish to add any suggestion/ instruction for the referees.
 - In most cases, you can centralize referee station, so every one sit side by side where easily to reach.
 - Check and brief the referees assigned per field of the rules and expectation that have to wait until replacement arrives.
 - constantly check the fields, touch line and team of referees ,provide assistance, defuse any trouble ,issues or assist referees to ease the game.
 - Constantly check with tournament coordinator if everything is going well.
 - Be visible and friendly partner to all parties (coaches, players, parents and referees) to create a positive environment.
 - Mentor, advise new/young or stressed referee who needs a tactical support.
 - At the end of the day make sure all games are covered, sort out the field assignment and report to LBSRA .include any adjustment done, advises to referees and issues.
- Your patience and knowledge of management will make differences,

Advices from your humble mentor leader for the up coming Season

The Moment of Truth

We All know that, in most games, a critical situation occur that have a direct effect on the match.

Most of the time, the Referees have to make a call on the incident and therefore become directly involved on the game's outcome.

Because of his decision that incident is referred to as the "**Moment of Truth**" or **(M.O.T)**

During the course of the game, moments like these can happened, for e Referee it is very difficult to explain what a **M.O.T.** is, because it is a very large concept.

We have the "significant, dramatic occurrences" That they are very apparent violations of the law of the game, they are serious foul play, and violent conduct, that should result to an ejection of the offender.

The following are some samples;

A defender denying a goal scoring opportunity by an attacker

Foul by a defender in the penalty area that result in a penalty kick

Deliberately striking an opponent

Tackle from behind that is dangerous and can cause injury to an opponent

In each of the above cases the offense it's so blatant that the Referee or at least one of his Assistants should called.

It is very important that that us Official be prepared to officiate any kinds of game and also be a student of the game because when we go on the field we have to prepared for everything that it is happening on the field on any given time.

In order To be ready to recognize the potential M.O.T. situations,

You have to follow these very important points:

*Know the laws of the game

*Be physically fit

*Do your home work

*Pre-game instructions

There are very rare games when an M.O.T. event does not happen, but you need to be prepare to make the best possible choice when it does.
