USSF Recertification Alert December, 2014

All Referees that has not re-certified for 2015, This is a friendly reminder that your 2014 USSF certification will expire at the end of this month. This means if you do not have your 2015 certification, you will not be allowed to officiate any games when the new year starts. Please remember that it normally takes up to 2 weeks to show approved from the time all your certification items are complete.

If you are missing in-service hours, this will be the only year we are providing you an opportunity to still register. We will forgive any hours you are still missing. Moving forward, please remember that you have the full 2015 year to participate in (5) in-service hours offered by local referee associations.

To recertify now, please follow the instructions outlined here.

LAWS OF THE GAME QUESTIONS YOU NEED TO KNOW THE ANSWERS

1._A substitute warming up behind his team's goal, sees that his team is in danger of conceding a goal. He enters the field of play and stops a goal being scored by kicking the ball away.

What decision should the referee make?

- 2.- An attacking player positions himself in the goal, at the same time, a teammate scores a goal. What action does the referee take if the player's action distracts an opponent?
- 3.- extra time is to be played to determine the winner of the match. Are payers entitled to an interval at half time of extra time?
- 4.- an Indirect free kick is awarded outside the penalty area of the defending team. The referee does not raise his arm to indicate that the kick is indirect and the ball is kicked into the goal. What decision should the referee make?
- 5,- During a match, a goal is scored after a deliberate handling of the ball. Is there any way this goal could be valid?
- 6.-the referee shows a yellow card for a reckless foul. The caution is his second and the payer is sent off. The assistant referee who is closest advises the referee that the ball had previously gone out over the goal line.

What should the referee do?

If you know the answers send me an email with the correct answers.

If you don't know, then you need to attend our next meeting to learn why most referees miss these questions when taking the National Test.

State/National cup games will be paid cash on the fields, held at Lancaster soccer Complex, hotel room will be provided for those wishes staying over night, teaming is advised. Mentor group referees will be assigned together, watched and mentored.
